





 $V_{DS}$  - Drain-to-Source Voltage (V)




On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage






Transfer Characteristics

#### Capacitance




On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature





Power Derating, Junction-to-Ambient



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
