




Fig 3. Safe operating area; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage




Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration



Fig 5. Output characteristics; drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values



Fig 6. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values



Fig 7. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values



Fig 8. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage



Fig 9. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values



Fig 10. Reverse diode current as a function of reverse diode voltage; typical values



Fig 11. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature





Fig 13. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature




